Residential Building in Schönegg

The new surfaces surrounding this residential building in Schönegg includes three main areas. The street area of Luzernerstrasse and the forecourt in front of the building are organized in a very simple way. A row of cubic wooden structures is located alongside the footpath and guides the traffic both to and from the visitors' parking lot. Graveled paths and asphalt link the independent buildings. A copper beech tree and a bench can be found in each courtyard. A concrete wall forms the dominating element of the design. The wall has different angles, reminiscent of rocky cliffs. The foot of the wall advances and retreats, giving it an almost folded appearance. The 'rock wall' and the graveled courtyards define the entire area and give it its character. Green lawns surrounded by hedges create the private garden areas for ground floor residents. The buildings are surrounded by flower meadows with single groups of trees. A direct path of concrete slabs separates the meadow from the large, mixed-use lawn.
